- Provision of equal access to education for children from ethnic minorities;
- Raising the level of education in preschool groups where Roma children are enrolled;
- Education in tolerance and preservation of Romani culture as part of the Bulgarian culture;
- Early school drop-out prevention and reintegration of drop-outs in the education system;
- Forming a responsible parentship about the education of the children;
- Raising the competences of the pedagogical staff to work in intercultural environment.

HEALTH CARE

- Decreasing children mortality
- Improvement of the health care for new borns and children at preschool age;
- Improvement of the prophylactics among Roma;
- Improvement of access to healthcare for Roma in disadvantaged position;
- Raising the health care knowledge of Roma;
- Increasing the number of people from ethnic minorities with healthcare insurances;
- Monitoring and evaluation of health status of people from ethnic minorities;

EMPLOYMENT

- Provision of information for Roma with the aim to get employed;
- Promotion of employment through qualification and prequalification;
- Promoting competitiveness through training how to look for jobs;
- Provision of permanent employment for individuals at active labor age;

RULE OF LAW AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

- Validation of tolerant interethnic relations through various forms of educational, cultural and educational activities;
- Strengthening the representation of Roma in public administration at all levels;
- Prevention of aggressive behavior in school and in various institutions;

HOUSING

- Improving the housing conditions of Roma and other vulnerable families;
- Improving the technical and community infrastructure and public utilities;

YOUTH ACTIVITIES

- Formation of attitudes among young people for active citizenship and initiative;
- Preservation, development and promotion of specific ethnic culture of the Roma as part of the Bulgarian national culture and creating conditions for equal access of Roma to public cultural life at different levels;
