

Byala Slatina:

Measures included in the JAP.

Employment:

- 1. Create conditions for employment of low-skilled Roma people;
- Organising qualification courses for unemployed Roma people
- Participation of the municipality in the state programs for subsidized employment
- Develop and implement of a project for a social enterprise;

Education:

- 1. Prevent school dropouts;
- Provide Literacy trainings for Roma adults;
- Appoint educational mediators in the schools and kindergartens;
- Reduce/eliminate kindergarten fees for poor Roma and non-Roma families
- Create a club of "Roma customs and culture" in the Roma neighbourhood;

Healthcare:

- 1. Improve the health status of Roma;
- Participation in national programs to provide prophylactic examinations for uninsured Roma people;
- Conducting health-related discussions with Roma people;
- Distribute information materials, brochures, etc.; Elaboration and implementation of a project for introduction of a social service "A baby kitchen"

Infrastructure:

- 1. Improving living conditions in neighbourhoods with compact Roma population
- Project for design and construction of technical infrastructure in Roma neighborhoods in terms of water supply, street network, sanitation;
- Providing public transport from the Roma neighbourhood to downtown of B. Slatina
- 2. Providing alternative accommodation in case of forced eviction of Roma families from their homes, which are illegally built or when there is a threat to their safety and health. The measures planned by 2017 are:
 - Needs Assessment of new houses and determining the types of possible new homes
 - Allocation of municipal land for construction plots
