




What is ROMACT T.C.C.?


Launched in 2016, ROMACT T.C.C. is a new component of the ROMACT Programme.







Study Visit: Bordeaux and Toulouse(FR) - Peshtera, Plovdiv and Pazardzhik (BG)

The cities of Toulouse and Bordeaux responded to the ROMACT TCC call with a joint application.
